

Computer Programmer

About the Job:

Programmer will assist in design and implement custom Web browser-based user interfaces utilizing a Microsoft SQL Server back-end. Programmer will take direction from Team Leader and client.

Programmer will need experience programming in the IntelliGrants product.

Programmer will be responsible for two separate custom applications; one system used to disburse grant funds to affected areas by natural disasters, one system for tracking law enforcement training among nationwide participants.

Candidates must have 3-5 years of professional programming experience.

Major responsibilities include:

- Assist in the design and programming of easy-to-use, high quality browser-based user interfaces.
- Clear communication with 3rd party contractor, describing the functionality of the system based on vendor requirements.
- Phone / web meetings account for 25% of weekly activity
- Create and modify custom applications to specifications.
- Debug software in the event of a bug or defect.
- Responsible for maintaining a system to facilitate the application, review, award and disbursement of grant funds.
- Responsible for maintaining training tracking system, facilitating the publishing, registration and financial administration of training courses.
- Perform other similar and related duties as required or as directed.

Qualifications for this position are:

- Associates Degree in Computer Science or equivalent.
- Solid Object Oriented programming skills with VB.NET, ASP.NET, MVC and ADO.NET in a Windows environment are necessary.
- Minimum three (3) years experience with VB.NET.
- Minimum three (3) years experience with SQL.
- Minimum three (3) years experience with data work flow management systems.
- Minimum one (1) year experience programming IntelliGrants product.
- Knowledge and expertise of the NY Rising Recovery system (disaster recovery relief system)
- Knowledge and expertise of the Florida Crime Prevention Training Institute system.
- Knowledge of financial systems administering grant funding to disaster recovery areas.
- Knowledge of rules pertaining to disaster relief efforts.
